Bella* recently returned to Georgia from New York City. She said the timing of her pregnancy was not good. She had goals, and a baby at this time would make reaching those goals difficult. She already had a 5-year-old daughter and was ready to enter nursing school. Plus, she did not have a good paying job.

During the appointment, Bella claimed to be a Christian and said she was praying for God to show her what to do. Our Client Advocate shared with Bella how to know God's will and not make decisions by feelings. Bella left the Center undecided.



Thankfully, Bella came back a week later for a follow-up ultrasound. As the heartbeat flickered on the screen, Bella told our nurse that, after considering her choices, she decided to carry the pregnancy.

Since the decision to give life to her unborn child, Bella said she received a well-paying, work-from-home job and made plans to start nursing school. Bella stated, "As things fell into place, I believe God confirmed my decision [to parent]." She feels hope.
